Mark Jansen

1960 - 2024



The LaSalle Rowing Club remembers the life of Mark Jansen, a cherished member of the Ontario rowing community and friend of LaSalle Rowing Club, who tragically passed away following a medical emergency during his coxed four race at the Head of Welland Five Bridges Regatta this September.

Mark was a Master's coach and rower with Leander Boat Club in Hamilton, with ties to the LaSalle Rowing community through his consummate volunteerism, immense knowledge base, and willingness to help other's. Mark was an integral part of LaSalle Rowing Club's trailer purchase, spending many hours discussing trailer specifications, the customs importation process, and the needs of competitive rowing crews more generally. Mark was always a phone call or email away and his input and advice helped shape competitive programming at the LaSalle Rowing Club.

Mark was deeply involved in his local rowing community, founding the Ancaster High School rowing team, driving the Leander trailer to regattas and building strong relationships throughout the rowing community through his kindness and collaborative approach to helping others.

Mark's sudden passing was a shock to his Leander family and all those racing at the Head of the Welland Regatta, including several LaSalle Rowing Club crews. The LaSalle Rowing Club wishes to extend our sincerest condolences to Mark's family and our friends at Leander Boat Club.


