Fun facts about rowing in the Olympics

- Rowing has been part of the Summer Olympics since its debut in the 1900 Games.
- Para rowing was introduced in the 2008 Beijing Summer Paralympics.
- Only men were allowed to compete until the women's events were introduced at the <u>1976 Summer</u> Olympics in Montreal
- <u>Lightweight rowing</u> events were introduced to the games in 1996 Summer Olympics in Atlanta. The 2024 Paris Olympics will be the last time these events will be hosted.

Canadian Olympic Rowing Facts

- The Canadian Olympians with the most rowing gold medals (3) and 1 bronze medal are Marnie McBean and Kathleen Heddle, who are rowing partners.
- Based after the 2020 Tokyo Olympics, Canada has 43 medals (10 Gold, 17 Silver, 16 Bronze)
- Canada has competed at each of the Paralympic Games, winning its first medal at the Rio 2016 Games in the LTAMix4+ event. Curtis Halladay, Victoria Nolan, Meghan Montgomery, Andrew Todd and Kristen Kit (coxwain) won a bronze medal.
