



Members Code of Conduct

Purpose:

The Member Code of Conduct provides an agreed standard of behavior that applies to all members

Obligations:

1. Members must always place safety above all else.
2. Members have a duty to avoid behavior that could constitute an act of disorder, misbehavior, law breaking, discrimination, theft, bullying and harassment
3. Members must act in a courteous and respectful manner to each other at all times. This means acting ethically and in a respectful manner both on and off the water, acting in a way which considers all other boaters, observing the rights of other people, and treating people with courtesy.
4. Members are required to understand and adhere to LRC procedures and polices
5. Members are to treat the LRC boathouse, rowing shells and all other equipment with respect and
perform all maintenance as required (washing of boats etc.)
6. Members are encouraged to assist in facility maintenance, cleanliness and club sanctioned activities by participating in volunteer work parties.
7. It is the responsibility of member to report all incidents (equipment damage, safety concerns) to the appropriate person immediately so that the situation can be remedied.
8. Members will be responsible for their guests and children at all times and ensure that their guest/s and or children's conduct is in keeping with the Club's Code of Conduct and the Club's rules and regulations.
9. Members agree to the consequences of any breach of the code of conduct. These may include suspension or termination from the club.
